○ 22ND LEGNICA INTERNATIONAL JEWELLERY COMPETITION REVOLT

The competition is the most important element of the Festival. It has an open character. The artists have to provide work on a given topic - a different one each year. Works should display original creativity and represent a high artistic standard. The international jury was composed of: Galit Gaon (Israel), Jiro Kamata (Japan / Germany), Hans Stofer (Switzerland / United Kingdom), Aneta Lis-Marcinkiewicz and Sławomir Fijałkowski (Poland). This year, 625 submissions were received from 319 artists of 43 countries, mainly from Europe, but also from Argentina, Australia, Israel, Japan, Korea and the USA.
